#### Building a Go-Bag for a Farm Animal: Items to Include

- Water & grain for at least 7 days
- Hay
- Buckets for food & water
- Halters & lead ropes
- Bedding (straw, shavings, etc.)
- Towels
- Electrolytes
- Medicine & livestock first aid kit
- Recent vaccination & identification records
